

Terms and Conditions

The purpose of Pregnancy Choices Tasmania

The Pregnancy Choices Tasmania website aims to provide a comprehensive, accessible, independently managed database of Tasmania's sexual and reproductive health services.

It is for the use of the general public and to assist health service providers find an up-to-date list of available services.

Women's Health Tasmania maintains the database and reserves the right to publish or not publish listings to ensure the database fulfils its purpose.

A listing in the database does not represent endorsement, recommendation, or promotion of the organisation or services listed.

Users of the database should not rely solely on the information provided and should also make their own enquiries and assessment of the suitability of services.

The types of organisations listed

The database includes GPs, pharmacies, private specialists, hospitals, imaging services, pathology services and non-directive pregnancy counselling services.

To be eligible to be registered in this data based, your service must

- Provide sexual and reproductive health services to Tasmanians
- Provide clients with access to the full range of options around pregnancy choices through direct service delivery or referrals

Women's Health Tasmania is not liable for any business losses, loss of revenue, income, profits or anticipated savings, loss of contracts or business relationships, loss of reputation or goodwill, or loss or corruption of information or data associated with listing on Pregnancy Choices Tasmania.

Women's Health Tasmania's rights and responsibilities

Women's Health Tasmania reserves the right to amend the Terms and Conditions at its discretion. We recommend you reread the Terms and Conditions each time you renew your listing.

Information which can be listed

Information on the website is restricted to the fields provided in the registration form.

It is the responsibility of the service provider submitting information to

- Ensure email addresses, phone numbers and other details are correct
- Ensure the contact information listed is suitable for public distribution (eg not private numbers)

How to register

1. Complete the online registration form. You must decide whether you want to be listed on the public or private database.
 - **Public listing:** your information is accessible to the public on the 'find a service' section of the website. The map will show the details you list on your registration form.
 - **Private listing:** your information will only be accessible to the Women's Health Tasmania staff. Your information will not be shown on the map but you are agreeing for our staff to share this information with clients.
2. Women's Health Tasmania staff will check the registration and enter your details into the database. You will be notified when this is completed, giving you an opportunity to check the website.

Reviewing and updating your listing

Each year we will contact you to ask you to renew your listing. This will be a prompt to check your details on the website and ensure their accuracy.

Deleting a listing

Service providers can ask for their listing to be removed at any time.

Terms and conditions for people using the website

Women's Health Tasmania makes reasonable efforts to ensure that information on this website is accurate.

The health information on the website is restricted to general health promotion information and does not constitute clinical advice. People with questions or concerns about their sexual and reproductive health are encouraged to talk to their health professional.

The inclusion of a service on this website does not constitute endorsement or recommendation of that service.

Although the website aims to be comprehensive, it is not exhaustive. Sexual and reproductive health services may choose not to register with the website. Women's Health Tasmania does not represent this as a complete list of services.

Links to external websites

Links to other websites are included on Pregnancy Choices Tasmania. Women's Health Tasmania takes reasonable care when choosing those websites but website users must make their own decisions about the accuracy, currency, reliability and correctness of information contained in linked external websites.

Privacy Policy

The Pregnancy Choices Tasmania website is bound by the provisions of the *Privacy Act 1988 (Cth)*, including the Australian Privacy Principles.

Collection of personal information

1. Website users

The Pregnancy Choices Tasmania website uses website analytics that collect high level of information about the visitors to the website and their activity while on the website. The information collected does not identify individual website users.

2. Health service providers

Health service providers registering with Pregnancy Choices Tasmania are responsible for the information they list on the website. It is recommended that private contact details are not included in the registration information.

Sharing information

The information on the public face of the website is publicly available for Tasmanians to use as stipulated in the terms and conditions.

Women's Health Tasmania will not use the information stored in the database for any purpose other than as a directory of Tasmanian sexual and reproductive health services.
